**Use of Approved Contractors:**

- 1 The charge-out rate will be the Contractor's charge out rate plus the IDBs overhead cost of £6.50/hour. This will be in addition to any In-house Technical Support Staff required to project manage delivery.
- 2 Where local contractors have similar equipment to the IDB, then they may be utilised where their charge-out rates, together with the IDBs overhead cost of £6.50/hour are in total less than or equal to the IDBs In-house cost/hour or where the IDBs In-house resource is fully committed, and in emergency events when capacity is an issue.
- 3 Where specialist equipment is required it will be hired in and charged-out at cost, with the IDBs overhead cost of £6.50/hour.
- 4 Contractors will usually be appointed after successfully bidding for the work as set out in our invitation to Tender documents as referenced in our Financial Regulations, emergencies excepted. Where urgent appointments need to be made, contractors will be selected from the Group's preferred supplier's schedule.
- 5 Our preference is always to use local trusted suppliers provided at the current best market rate, which we achieve through a minimum of three competitive quotes, appointing on a balance of cost and quality not just the most economic.

**In-house Resources and Approved Contractors:**

- 1 The net charge for each job will also include the cost of all materials used, any specialist plant hire charges incurred along with any associated legal and professional fees, and, the external costs of specialist consultants employed.
- 2 All prices are subject to VAT at 20%.
- 3 These charge-out rates will apply from 01 April 2021 until 31 March 2022.
